Winter Trap Shooting

Winter trap shooting is in progress. On Saturdays from 11 am-2 or 3 pm, through the third week of March, a winter club league competes and open trap shooting is available. Both trap houses are running for these events. Attendance has been really good and the weather has been cooperating! Come and join us for a couple hours and participate in this enjoyable sport. The kitchen is opened so you can warm up with some good food and drink too.

Members and non-members are welcomed to participate in open trap shooting. If you are interested in trap shooting or need to dust off those sights and sharpen up your skills, winter is the perfect time to get going. The cost for open trap, December thru March is \$4.00 per round (25 birds) for adults. The winter trap league's final shoot and banquet will be Saturday, March 24th starting at 10 am. Those attending the league banquet are asked to bring a dish to pass.

There won"t be any trap on February 18th, March 17th or 31st. Club rules require all shooters to wear eye and ear protection when shooting.

Spring Trap League

Spring trap league practice and open trap will begin Monday, April 2nd at 5:00 pm. The cost for open shooting from April thru November is \$3.00 per round for adults. The cost for junior shooters is \$2.00 per round all year long.

The first match will be April 10th when Northsportsman's Club competes against South Shore at South Shore's club.
