Range Rules Refresher

We had a situation when the main gate was found locked and rifle range gate was unlocked. Another situation arose when the club house door was left unlocked at rifle range. Please make sure you lock any gate / door / clubhouse when you are the last to leave. Double check if needed to be sure you know this status.

Also there is to be no bird shot allowed on rifle/pistol ranges because it destroys target supports too quickly. Use of bird shot is for the trap field only.
