Reminder

Please display your badge when on the club grounds and abide by our **guest policy**:

1. A guest may visit the grounds for the purpose of prospective membership. While doing so they are not permitted to use any of the range facilities. This does not apply to organized events.
2. An active member may seek permission for an out of town guest to utilize the range facilities for one day from a member of the B.O.D. The guest will be required to sign a liability waiver prior to their use of the facility.
3. A member can purchase up to Three (3) day guest passes for Five (\$5) Dollars each (per year) for a prospective member to try out the club.
 - a) A guest may only visit once (1) on a guest pass. (After which they will have to become a member).
 - b) Pass must be purchased from the president with the name of the guest documented at time of purchase.
 - c) A member may only have one guest at a time and takes full responsibility for their guest
 - d) Guest Policy and Guest Passes are suspended on Fridays-Sundays from September 1st to December 1st
 - e) Guests must sign a liability waiver
